HOUGHTON - Although Art Simila couldn't be at the 12th annual Copper Country Association of School Boards awards presentation Wednesday, his more than 20 years of service to local education were still acknowledged.

At the Michigan Technological University Memorial Union Building Ballroom, Albert Koskela, president of the Copper Country Intermediate School District Board of Education, presented the award for Copper Country Education Leadership Award to Simila, who is hospitalized in Marquette.

Koskela said in 1965, Simila was appointed the first representative of Keweenaw County on the newly created CCISD. He was later elected to the board, and in the last 26 years, he has helped in every position from trustee, treasurer, vice president and president.

"He spent a lot of time with the schools," Koskela said.

Being from Ahmeek, Koskela said, Simila was active with furthering education efforts in Keweenaw County.

"When they built the Mohawk (elementary) school, he was instrumental in that," he said.

Koskela said he expected Simila's daughter to take the award to Simila in Marquette.

The presentation of Simila's was the last after awards were given by representatives of member schools for student leadership, outstanding education employee and school service.
