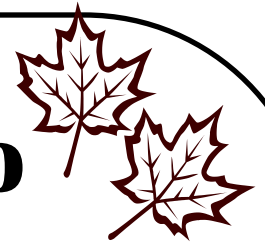

Directions to the Paavola Preserve:

1. From Hancock, take US-41 towards Calumet.
2. At the Quincy Hill blinking light, travel approximately 1.5 miles to the No. 9 Road.
3. Turn right onto No. 9 Road, and follow 0.6 miles to the small trailhead.
4. Please drive slowly & park along the side of the road near the preserve.
