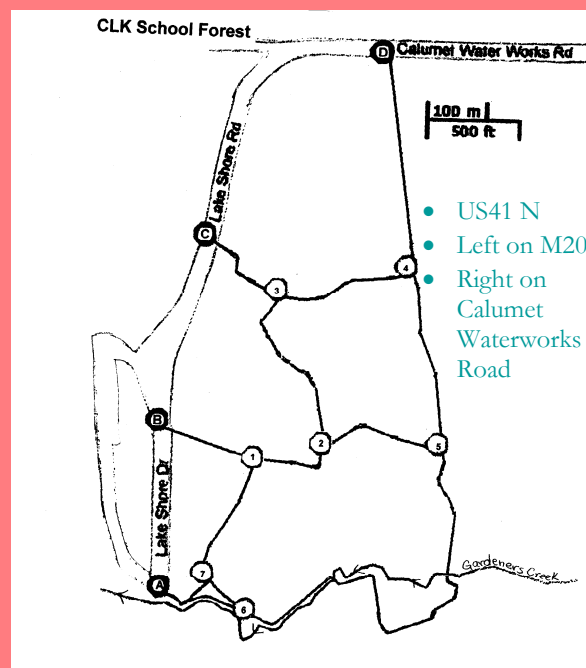


Michigan's Beaches: Our Goal

Spotted Knapweed

Spotted Knapweed is an invasive species (not native to our area). It kills our native plants with toxins, spreading itself.



Local Help

All around people are working on stopping the species by removing it from the area. You can help by digging up the roots and collecting the plants.

Youth Action

Even kids can help! The Public Schools of CLK cleaned up their school forest and the Calumet Waterworks Park working with the Lake Superior Stewardship Initiative (LSSI). They collected 182 pounds of spotted knapweed and (just as an example) they collected 222 cigarette butts from the ground.
